## **WHAT IS THE CHRISTMAS DAY PARTY?**

Our celebrations on 25<sup>th</sup> December each year brings together a wide range of people who would otherwise be on their own (including couples) on Christmas Day for a traditional family party.

On the big day itself, guests arrive from mid-day and are welcomed with drinks and nibbles. Following a traditional Christmas Lunch, the afternoon includes the Kings Speech, entertainment, a sing-a-long and a visit from Santa before people start to leave around 4pm with a gift and piece of Christmas cake to take home.

## **HOW DOES IT WORK?**

Anyone within our local community, including Sawtry and its surrounding villages, can apply for a place by contacting the CARESCO Office from mid-September onwards.

The day is organised by a team of volunteers and guests who are willing and able are invited to get involved with the planning and preparations in advance.

There are limited spaces available, so an early application is advisable to avoid disappointment. Help with transport is available if needed, but the team are unable to provide and personal care on the day.

## **HOW MUCH DOES IT COST?**

There is no charge for attending the CARESCO Centre, though donations towards costs are always welcome.

There will be a £10 charge per person for a home delivery. Payment will be required in advance.

Any contributions can be made via the CARESCO Office, clearly marked for the 'Christmas Day Party'.
